

Minutes of SEMARC Board Meeting of September 14, 2021 (Approved October 12, 2021)

This was a virtual online meeting by Webex.

Meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm by President Ryc Lyden KDØZWM.

Activities Report – Larson reported a successful Parks On The Air event on August 28 at Afton State Park. Blume reported a successful POTA event on September 11 at Jaycee Park in Hastings. There were 103 FT8 contacts, 17 CW contacts and 3 phone contacts.

Old Business

- 1. Club equipment. Roberts and Schultz will inventory donated equipment next week. Blume will contact Cottage Grove Fire Chief to confirm method to secure storage room at Fire Station #3.
- 2. The Cottage Grove EOC is in the Public Safety Building; Central Fire Station is the back-up EOC. Discussion that we could establish an emergency station at Fire Station #3 and use portable radios from there to contact the city EOC. There is no need to install a permanent radio station at either EOC.
- 3. Continued discussion from last month about membership for those who pass one of our VE exams. Motion to offer free membership to those who pass one of our VE exams from January through September for the remainder of the calendar year, and those who pass an exam from October through December for the remainder of the same and the succeeding calendar year. - 2. Possible locations for an October field event were discussed. None decided.
