#### FIELD DAY

Field Day 2020 is now behind us. Several of our members participated from their QTH or Portable locations. Reports received indicate the band conditions were not good at times and at other times so busy you couldn't bust thru to make your QSO's. In my case I was in Wisconsin and did not have much free time to get on the air. I went to a close by city park and operated with battery power as a Class 1B. ARRL rules said I had to operate QRP at no more than 5 watts. I operated on Sunday morning from about 0900-1100 hours and 40M was very busy. It was frustrating because I wasn't able to get thru at 5 watts to get my contacts. I only managed one QSO but was able to claim 100 bonus points for emergency power, another hundred for operating in a public park, and fifty more for submitting my results to the ARRL electronically. The multiplier for 5 watts is 5, so I ended up with 255 points.

Summertime brings one of my favorite on-air celebrations - the IARU HF Championship. This year the celebration/contest occurs on July 11, beginning at 7:00 AM local and continuing for 12 hours. The exchange includes a signal report and ITU zone. In Minnesota, we are in ITU Zone 7.

Multiply that by 172, the number of member societies in the Union. What a possible gas! Also, officers of the union can be worked and serve as additional multipliers in your score.
