KØA FLIES AGAIN

The Board recently chose September 26 as the date to reprise our special event commemorating the Airway Beacon System used by early pilots in carrying the U.S. Mail. As in a past special event, the club secured the call sign

In 1920, the U.S. established the North Transcontinental Air Mail Route. By 1924, ground- based navigation aids were in place. The aids consisted of lighted airway towers mounted on concrete arrows indicating the direction of the next link in the system. In fact, two of the artifacts remain in Minnesota: a concrete arrow which can be viewed in Cottage Grove; and a lighted tower in Mounds Park in St. Paul. The ground-based system continued for a number of years before functioning radio navigation in airplanes became common.

Previously, a group of members operated from the actual tower installation in Mounds Park.

It will be a fine Autumn operating event for the club.
