

SEMARC 2-meter Net Control Station Script

Opening: Good evening, this is (your call sign) on the WØCGM repeater. I want to welcome everyone to the regular SEMARC Wednesday night 2-meter net. The South East Metro Amateur Radio Club is located in the southeast corner of the metropolitan area. It is affiliated with the ARRL and is a Special Service Club. This net meets every Wednesday at 8:00 PM on this repeater at 146.985 with a negative offset and no access tone. The objectives of this net include amateur radio emergency service (ARES) check-ins, the exchange of information between members, regular SEMARC club communications, and the practice of net communications. This is a controlled net. All traffic and comments should be directed to your net control station. Again, net control this evening is (your call sign) and my name is (your first name).

First, we'll stand by for emergency or urgent traffic. Anyone with emergency or urgent traffic call now. Are there any relays for emergency traffic?

If no response, state: Nothing heard

ARES Net:

Next, I'd like to check in ARES members. ARES members only. Please give your complete call sign slowly, with your first name, county location, and whether or not you have traffic or announcements for ARES. Are there any more ARES members wishing to check in?

- Thanks to all ARES members for checking in and for supporting ARES.
- I am closing the ARES portion of the net at (local time). This is (your call sign), net control station.

Activity net:

Now, I'll open the activity portion of the net. Any licensed amateur radio operator may check in. If you have already checked into the ARES net, you do not need to recheck into the activity net. All other amateurs check in with your call sign and indicate if you have announcements now. Any additional stations wishing to check in?

SEMARC club announcements:

- The slow speed CW net is held every Wednesday at 7:00 PM central time on 28.110.
- The 2-meter Nets are held starting at 8:00 PM on WØCGM repeater 146.985 at 8:00 PM.
- The WINLINK net is held following the regular 2-meter net with check-ins beginning on WØCGM repeater.
- The SEMARC club meeting is held on the last Tuesday of the month at 7:00 PM at St. Luke Lutheran Church on Hinton Trail in Cottage Grove. There is a short business meeting followed by a presentation on some aspect of amateur radio.
- SEMARC offers VE testing and sessions are held monthly on the 3rd Saturday at 9:00am. Details are on the web site for Technician, General, and Extra exams.
